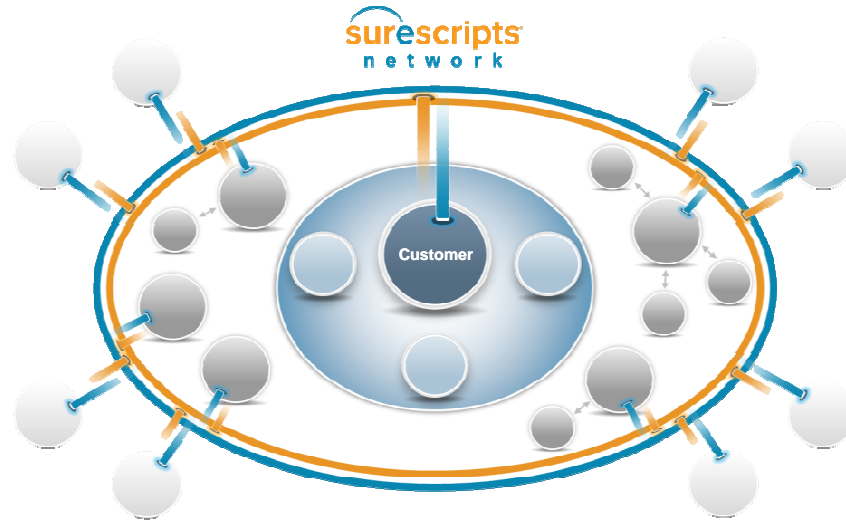

# Benefits of Joining the Network

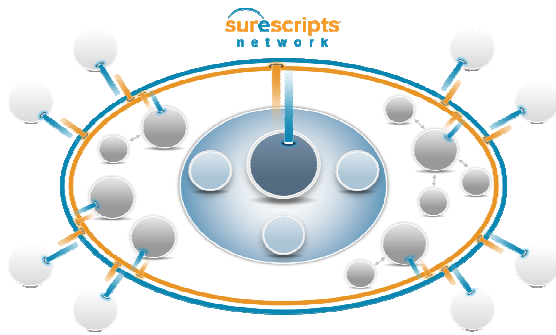


- Access to a shared, searchable **Directory** of all Surescripts Network participants.
- Support for **Direct Project** Protocols
- Automatic **Certification** – ensures messages traveling across the Network will reach their destination, even to Direct inboxes, and that messages you receive will not be “spam”.
- Support for Stage 2 and 3 **Meaningful Use** requirements as they emerge.

# The Direct Project and Surescripts



**The Direct Project**



The Direct Project is a set of standards and services that can be adopted to enable point to point communications.

Surescripts is a Secure Network of users that is Direct Project compliant.

- In other words, Surescripts gives you Direct Project messaging, **plus**:
  - **Directories** of Surescripts enabled partners, regardless of their system of record
  - **Secure communication with any participant** – including those using Direct addressees and those that are unaffiliated with Surescripts or Direct platforms
  - **Central management of Business Associate Agreement** relationships, and all the other complexities inherent in creating your own peer-to-peer network
  - Support for **Stage 2 and 3 of Meaningful Use**, including the much more complex bi-directional and synchronous communication requirements to come

# Supporting Meaningful Use

## Network Connectivity Can Assist With Achievement of the Following Meaningful Use Requirements

Stages	Selected Requirements – Improved Care Coordination*
<b>Stage 1</b>	Perform test of HIE connectivity
	Medication reconciliation conducted at 50% of care transitions by receiving provider
	Summary care record provided electronically for 50% of transitions and referrals (Optional 'menu' measure)
<b>Stage 2 (Proposed)</b>	Connect to at least 3 external providers in 'primary referral network' or establish an ongoing bidirectional connection to at least one health information exchange
	Medication reconciliation conducted at 80% of care transitions by receiving provider
	Summary care record provided electronically for 50% of transitions and referrals (Core Requirement)
<b>Stage 3 (Proposed)</b>	Connect to at least 30% of external providers in 'primary referral network' or establish an ongoing bidirectional connection to at least one health information exchange
	Medication reconciliation conducted at 90% of care transitions by receiving provider
	Summary care record provided electronically for 80% of transitions and referrals

# Surescripts and GE Secure Messaging

- GE Secure Messaging doesn't change:
  - Your **workflows** stay the same
  - Your **address books** stay the same
  - The **messaging tab** stays the same
  - **Patient Messaging** to the Portal stays the same
  - **Encounter Form integration** stays the same
- What does change:
  - The **number of providers** you can connect to will expand
  - Providers you do business with can **find you in the Directory**
  - Those providers can send and receive electronically **from their desktop**

# Joining the Surescripts Network

## Joining is as easy as 1-2-3

1. Sign the Subscription Agreement
2. Configure Secure Messaging to communicate with the Network
3. Create Surescripts Directory entries for the providers in your organization
